

INSTRUMENTATION TECHNICIAN

Position Summary:

Instrumentation Technician is a team member responsible for scheduled and emergency instrumentation and electrical activities on production and operating equipment, including the buildings and grounds.

Hours:

Base work schedule is Monday thru Friday, 7 am - 3:30 pm with overtime as needed for business necessity. Evenings and weekends may be necessary due to business needs. Will carry pager about one weekend per month.

Position Requirements:

- Minimum two years industrial instrumentation experience in manufacturing environment.

- Experience in food grade or pharmaceutical grade industrial facility strongly preferred.

General Job Duties:

- Analyze, troubleshoot and repair instrumentation of automated equipment including, but not limited to, Programmable Logic Controllers, motors and other electrical equipment, flow meters, electrical trace, and building wiring.
- Record and maintain database on equipment information, preventative and regular maintenance and repairs as per quality programs and SOP's.
- Required to carry pager as scheduled; available for emergency call-ins and overtime as needed.
